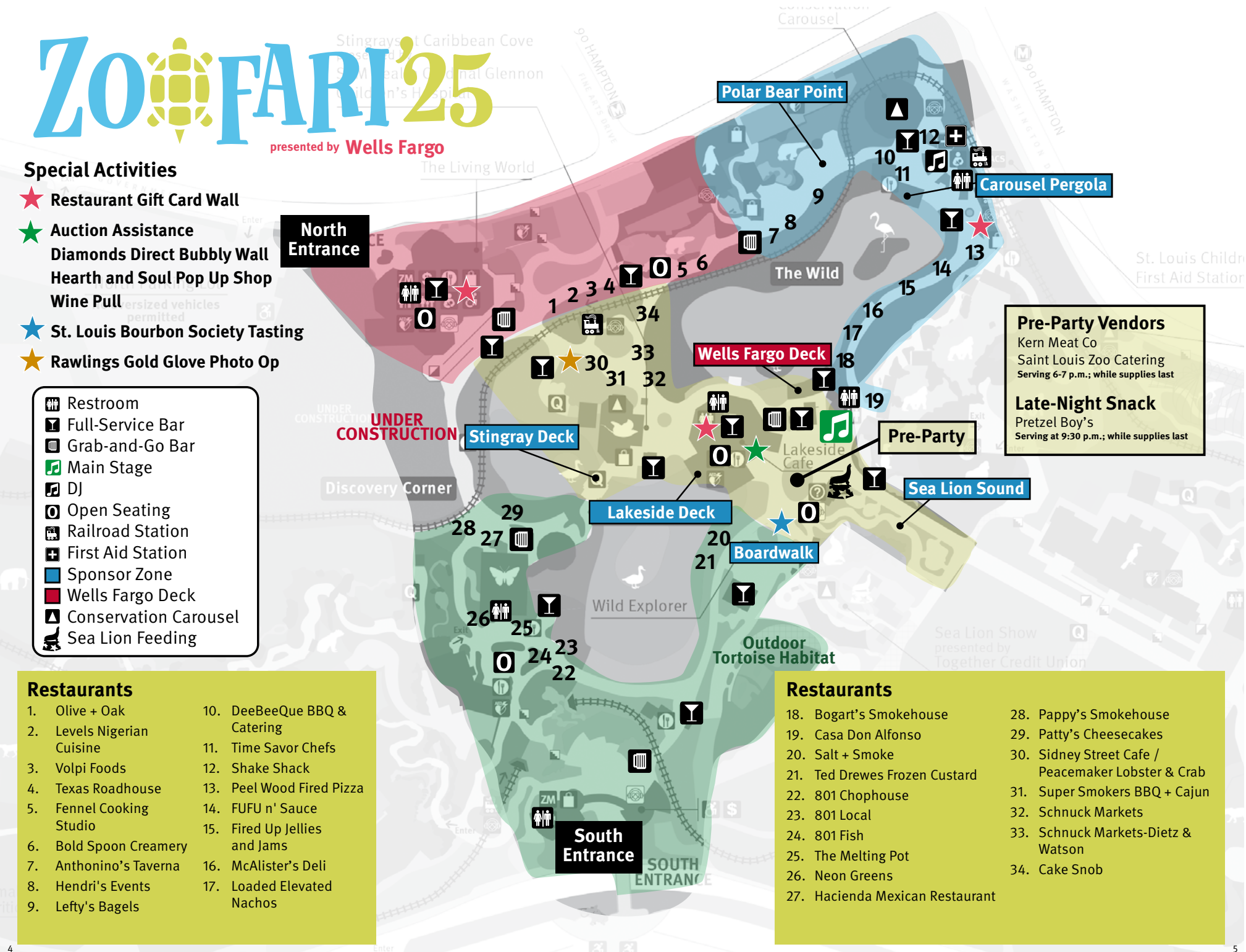

## About Giant Tortoises: Saving the Gentle Giants

Majestic, ancient and full of wonder, Aldabra and Galapagos tortoises are living links to a prehistoric past. Giant tortoises once roamed nearly every continent on Earth, but human activity pushed them to the brink of extinction. Today, giant tortoises remain only in the remote Islands of the Galapagos and Seychelles, largely thanks to global conservation efforts. These gentle giants have survived the odds, but they still need our help.

The Saint Louis Zoo has long been a key player in tortoise conservation, both here and around the world. Over the last 12 years, the Zoo has conducted scientific exploration, trained the next generation of conservationists, and engaged local communities in the Galapagos as a member institution in the Galapagos Tortoise Movement Ecology Program.

Together, we can ensure that these slow-moving wonders continue their journey for generations to come.
